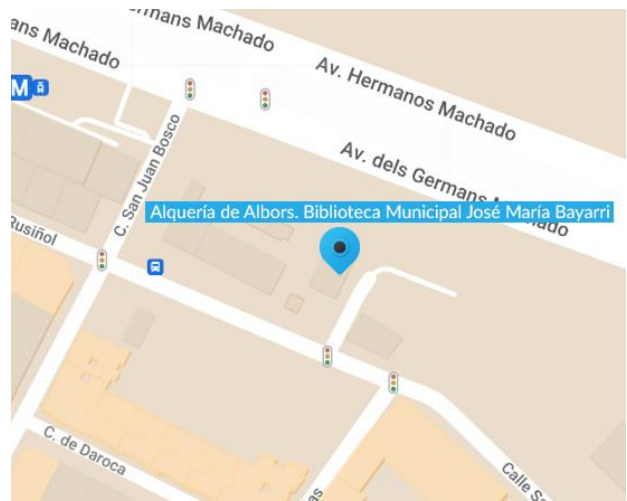
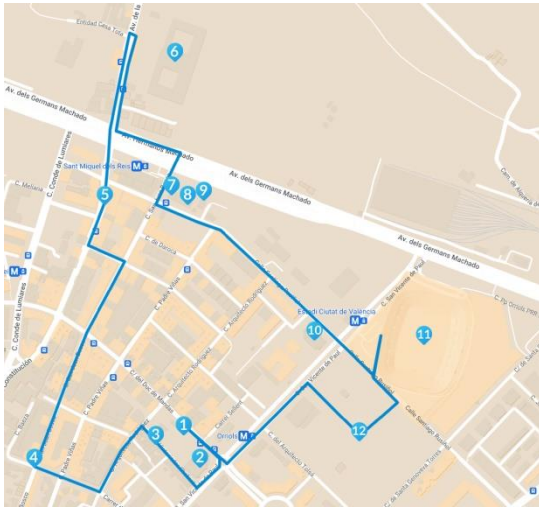


9. José Maria Bayarri Municipal Library



The Municipal Library was opened in 2022.

The José Bayarri Municipal Library is part of Orriols' socio-cultural unit, along with the Municipal Youth Centre and the People's University.

It is somewhat separate from the other facilities, at the easternmost end of the Alqueria de Albors complex.

The refurbishment retained some external brick walls and part of the wooden and Arabian tile roof.

The library is on the ground floor. The rest of the building will be a cultural centre.

The 17th century building is built on a structure of medieval origin. Until the 19th century, it was owned by San Miguel de los Reyes monastery. It is dedicated to the Valencian writer, poet, painter and sculptor José María Bayarri.

It is dedicated to the Valencian writer, poet, painter and sculptor José María Bayarri (1886- 1970), who grew up in Alboraya. He trained as a sculptor in the workshop of the Capuz Julio brothers. He was a student of the Valencian language, and a proponent of its culture and of literature in general. He was also professor of anatomy at the School of Fine Arts.

His prolific career encompassed social poetry in 1915 and works of art criticism about the Pinazo and the Benlliure in 1920. At that time, he also wrote poetry on religious themes. In 1928 he wrote patriotic poetry and historical drama in 1929.

From the late 1940s and throughout the 1950s, he published poetry on about sentimental and family themes, as well as spiritual and religious themes.

It is a classic of cultural Valencianism notable for its religiosity and its love for València.

How to get there on foot?

From the Municipal Youth Centre, follow Santiago Rusiñol street for about 60 m and go towards camino Alquería Albors in the eastern part of the Alquería de Albors cultural complex.

General information

Opening hours:

- Mornings: 08:45 to 14:45
- Afternoons: from 16:15 to 19:45
- Saturdays: from 09:30 to 13:30

The opening hours may change every month; call for details.

The Library is on a flat street with homogeneous paving.

Parking

There is an open space right outside the Library door where you can park.

To go from the field to the entrance of the library there is an 11 cm high kerb.

A public space has been reserved for PRM in Santiago Rusiñol street, No. 7; it is 400 cm x 200 cm, with vertical and horizontal signage. Slope free access to the Library with dips in the pavements.

A public space has been reserved for PRM in Santiago Rusiñol street, No. 10; it is 600 cm x 200 cm, with vertical and horizontal signage. Slope free access to the Library with dips in the pavements.

Nearby Valenbici station in San Juan Bosco street level with the Universitat Popular.

Access

Access from a flat, slope free street.

Double leaf building access door, when the library is open one leaf permanently open, with 83 cm clear passage width per leaf.

Access door to the library, open permanently, with more than 200 cm of free passage width.

Mobility indoors

The building has two floors; the library is on the ground floor.

Corridors that are more than 250 cm wide, with no occasional narrowings or slopes. Flooring free of projections, and non slip.

The Library is an open area, with free passage of more than 60 cm between tables and chairs.

The space between the bookcases is more than 120 cm The books on the shelves are at a height of between 15 and 210 cm.

It has an information point with a counter at a height of 112 cm with a 75 cm high area.

Toilet

There is only one toilet; it is unisex and adapted.

Door signage with approved symbol. Non-slip flooring.

The toilet area access door has 80 cm of width free of passage; it opens inwards by means of a handle at a height of 102 cm.

Slope free toilet door with 74 cm of free passage width. A 150 cm diameter circle can be described in front of the door.

In case of emergency, the lock can be opened from the outside.

A circle with a diameter of more than 150 cm can be described within the cabin.

The sink lacks a pedestal or skirting and is 89 cm high. Lower clear height of 75 cm and 54 cm deep. It is not possible to use it from the toilet.

It has an elderly friendly tap.

Support bars that can be folded on both sides, at a height of 58-75 cm. 65 cm separation between bars.

There is a non-tilted mirror with a lower edge 120 cm from the floor.

There is a toilet access space of approximately 150 cm on the right side, 106 cm on the left and approximately 130 cm of frontal access.

The toilet seat is at a height of 43 cm.

Lighting without a timer.

There is an alarm system inside the toilet.

Access

Access from a flat, slope free street.

There is an access door that is always open when the library is open.

Mobility indoors

The building has two floors; the library is on the ground floor.

On the ground floor, there is a slope free route with corridors more than 120 cm wide and non slip flooring free of projections. Route free of obstacles and no unmarked projecting elements.

There are information signs with contrasting pictograms.

Homogeneous lighting.

Toilet

Unisex toilets marked with non.

tactile pictograms, approved, and with chromatic contrast, at a height of between 140 cm and 175 cm.

The toilet door contrasts with the wall.

Homogeneous lighting without a timer.

Access

The access door does not permit visual communication with the inside.

Mobility indoors

Written information is provided regarding the services provided. There are information panels with pictograms or short texts that mark spaces and itineraries.

There is an information point at the entrance of the library. It does not have a magnetic induction loop.

Toilet

There is a visual vacant/engaged system.

There is no lower clearance strip on the cabin door.
